2009 Summer B Dining Membership Terms & Conditions

This agreement is made between UCF Dining Services and the dining membership payer and/or recipient, who agree to the following:

Payment Provisions (Initial that you have read _____)

1. A \$30 returned check fee will be charged for any returned checks.
2. Submit the completed and signed dining membership agreement with payment in person to the UCF Dining Services Business Office (located next to the Marketplace), by fax 407-823-0053, or by mail to UCF Dining Services, P.O. Box 168017, Orlando, FL 32816-8017. A dining membership agreement, including these terms and conditions, can also be downloaded by visiting www.UCFDining.com.

Dining Membership Provisions (Initial that you have read _____)

1. Your UCF ID, which serves as your dining card, is required for all transactions – exceptions will not be permitted.
2. Block plans meals do not carry over from semester to semester.
3. Resident Dining memberships are not transferable to others. Members may bring in guests with the FlexBucks portion of their account only.
4. Block Memberships may use their meals for guest. All dining membership meals must be eaten in the Marketplace.
5. A one-week grace period is provided for dining membership changes. Summer B grace period ends 07/01/2009. Service charges and other restrictions may apply. Please see a dining representative for further details.
6. The dining week runs from Wednesday morning to Tuesday late night. Unused meals do not carry forward to the next week or next semester. Visits on block dining memberships must be used within one semester. Unused visits do not carry forward to the next semester.
7. If your UCF ID card is lost or stolen, you must immediately report it to a Dining Services representative; UCF Dining Services cannot be held responsible for any unauthorized purchases. Failure to report a lost or stolen card may result in a loss of funds. You must also apply for a new one at the UCF Card Office. Replacement cards are \$15.
8. UCF Dining Services reserves the right to alter services or hours of operation. Notice will be given with modified schedules posted in all dining locations and online at www.ucfdining.com. We will be closed in observance of Independence Day July 3rd and 4th 2009.
9. Marketplace will be open on June 27th 2009 at 11 am for lunch and will close at 2 pm on August 5th 2009.

FlexBucks and FlexBucks Plus (Initial that you have read _____)

1. FlexBucks Plus may be added to any dining membership, and will carry over until graduation or withdrawal from the university. Participants are expected to notify UCF Dining Services for a refund in writing. If participants fail to notify UCF Dining Services for a refund and remain inactive after graduation or withdrawal for a period of six weeks or longer, then the remaining money is forfeited.
2. Dining Membership FlexBucks are nonrefundable. Unused Dining Membership FlexBucks will be forfeited at the end of Summer B session on 08/07/09.
3. FlexBucks and FlexBucks Plus may be used at any UCF Dining Services location, which will be identified by in-store signage and in the UCF Dining Services Brochure.
4. Funds may be added at any time by contacting the UCF Dining Services Office or by visiting the website. There are no minimums to maintain.

Cancellation Policy (Initial that you have read _____)

All requests for dining membership cancellation, as outlined below, must be accompanied by documentation from the university that you have either withdrawn from the university or that your housing contract has been cancelled. The amount of your refund is based on the date UCF Dining Services receives the documentation noted above. The refund value for all dining memberships is recalculated on a weekly basis throughout the semester. All cancellations are subject to a \$100 cancellation fee. If you submit a medical reason it must be approved by UCF Dining Services. If approved prior to the start of the dining membership, the cancellation fee will be waived.

1. If you officially withdraw from the university (academic disqualification or probation, medical (UCF approved) or late) and you notify us prior to the start of the academic semester, your dining membership contract will be cancelled and you are entitled to a full refund without a cancellation fee.
2. If you officially withdraw from the university (academic disqualification or probation, medical (UCF approved) or late) and you notify us after the start of the academic semester, or inform us of your withdrawal after the academic semester has begun, you are entitled to a refund of the remaining value of the membership, as recalculated on weekly basis and will be charged a \$100 cancellation fee.
3. If your housing contract is canceled and you notify us prior to the start of the academic semester, you may cancel your dining membership contract and receive a full refund without a cancellation fee.
4. If your housing contract is canceled after the start of the academic semester and you remain a current UCF student, you are entitled to a refund of the remaining value of the membership, as recalculated on a weekly basis and will be charged a \$100 cancellation fee.
5. There are no cancellations or refunds on Block Dining Memberships.
