## A full menu of choices

From breakfast to a late-night snack, you can find what you want, where you want. when you want.

**Residential Restaurant at Larson Commons.** Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are made-to-order at this all-you-care-to-eat location. Block meals and Flex dollars are accepted here.

**Jacks' Place.** Use your Flex dollars for pizzas, calzones, and toasted subs in this fun, relaxed atmosphere.



**Jackrabbit Convenience Store.** Dash into this on-campus market for snacks, beverages, and even items like toothpaste. Flex dollars can be used here.



**C<sup>3</sup> Express.** Energize with a Starbucks coffee or grab a quick snack using your Flex dollars while cramming for a big test at the C<sup>3</sup> in Briggs Library.



**Food Courts.** Located in the Student Union and Medary Commons, Flex dollars can be used for a variety of food selections both to dine in and to go.



**Coffee Houses.** Get your caffeine buzz and indulge in baked goodies using Flex dollars at one of the three comfy cafés located in the Union, NFA, and Medary.



## Pick the plan for you

Flexibility makes it easy to get the most value out of your plan. There are two parts to each meal plan:

### Block Meals

Choose how many all-you-care-to-eat breakfast, lunch, and dinner meals you want to eat in our Residential Restaurant per semester.

### Flex Dollars

Accepted at all dining locations, Flex works like a debit card, subtracting your purchases from the balance in your account.

Once you have a meal plan, your student ID works like a debit card. Just swipe your card and the meal charge is deducted from your account automatically.

Block meals must be used up by the end of EACH semester. Flex will transfer from fall to spring but NOT from spring to fall.

# Stretch your dollars further

Whether you're eating on campus every day or just a few times a week, you could be saving money with a meal plan. Tons of options help you choose the plan that offers the best value for your busy schedule.

## Best Values

**Silver Flex** is the best value if you eat at many different locations around campus and keep irregular hours.

**75 Block** is the best value if you dine at Larson Commons Residential Restaurant 2-5 times a week.

**100 Block or 150 Block** is the best value if you dine at Larson Commons Residential Restaurant at least 2 meals every day.

the total cost of each plan includes a bond & utility fee, as well as sales tax.*

- Unlimited all-you-care-to eat meals/semester at Larson Commons
- \$53.50 Flex for ALL Jacks' Dining locations
- \$1,564.05/ semester

### 150 Block

- 150 all-you-care-to eat meals/ semester at Larson Commons
- \$262.15 Flex for ALL Jacks' Dining locations
- \$1,256.65/semester

### 100 Block

- 100 all-you-care-to eat meals/semester at Larson Commons
- \$428.00 Flex for ALL Jacks' Dining locations
- \$1,256.65/semester

### \*75 Block

- 75 all-you-care-to eat meals/semester at Larson Commons
- \$214.00 Flex for MOST Jacks' Dining locations
- \$866.35/semester

### Gold Flex

- \$1,402.90 Flex for ALL Jacks' Dining locations
- \$1,564.05/semester

### Silver Flex

- \$1,095.45 Flex for ALL Jacks' Dining locations
- \$1,256.60/semester

### \*Bronze Flex

- \$942.20 Flex for MOST Jacks' Dining locations
- \$1,103.35/semester

*\*Plan available only to third semester students and above and cannot be used at the Dairy Bar or the Meat Lab.*

*Meals can only be used at Larson Commons. Flex Dollars can be used at any location unless otherwise noted. All prices are per semester.*

## FAQ's

### **Do I need to have a meal plan?**

All students living in a residence hall are required to have a meal plan EACH semester.

### **Can I change my meal plan?**

Yes. For the first two weeks of each semester you can change your plan by simply going to the Dining Office in the Student Union and completing a Membership Change Form.

### **Can I treat others to a meal on my plan?**

You may spend your block meals and Flex dollars on whomever you choose. However, YOU must be present with your ID to make that purchase. For the security of your account, please do not give your ID to another to use. (Those on Premier Plan may only purchase meals for themselves).

### **Can I carry over my unused block meals to the next semester?**

There are no meal plans that allow you to carry over block meals from one semester to the next.

### **Can I carry over my unused Flex Dollars to the next semester?**

All Flex left at the end of the fall semester, regardless of your plan, will transfer to the spring semester. All unused Flex from spring semester are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to the new academic year.

### **What do I do if my Flex Dollars run low?**

Go to the Card Office in the Student Union and tell them you want to replenish your Flex. Simply make a deposit to your account by cash, check, money order, or credit card. Or add more at our website under the 'meal plan' tab at [www.SDSU.campusdish.com](http://www.SDSU.campusdish.com).
