

# Kosher Dining at U.Va.

U.Va. Dining provides kosher dining at the University of Virginia in partnership with the Hillel House at the University of Virginia. Hillel House provides kosher meals at both lunch and dinner for Newcomb Dining Room and Observatory Hill Dining Room. U.Va. Dining does not keep a kosher kitchen, therefore all meals come from Hillel House.

All of the meals are prepared in the Hill House's kosher kitchen under supervision and are then delivered to the residential dining rooms. U.Va.

Dining also delivers fresh kosher prepared sandwiches and salads to the residential dining rooms daily, Monday-Thursday, giving customers a choice of two sandwiches, an entrée salad, or a hot meal with an entrée and sides during the week. Customers can also help themselves to any of the food offerings in the residential dining rooms.
