Can I treat a friend by using two "meals" in a meal period?

All-you-care-to-eat meals are only for your use and you may use only one meal per meal period. If you would like to treat a friend, you have the option of purchasing additional meals using Dining Dollars.

What do I do when my Dining Dollars run low?

Reload. Simply add additional Dining Dollars to your account with cash, check, money order or credit card by visiting the Housing Office (located in Jones Hall) or call 940-898-3565.

At the end of spring semester, unused dollars are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to the new academic year.

Our meal plans are flexible so you can get the most out of them. There are two parts to the meal plan program, which enable you to select a plan that's just right for you.

Weekly Meal Allowance

- Designed for students living on campus
- Enjoy all-you-care-to-eat dining for breakfast, lunch, and dinner in The Underground.
- Receive a set number of meals per week; each time you eat in The Underground, one meal is subtracted from your weekly meal allowance

Dining Dollars

- Supplements semester meal plan allowance
- Can be used in all of our service locations
- Works like a bank debit card; each time you make a purchase the total is subtracted from the balance in your account

12 Meal Plan Plus \$1,250 + tax

- Up to 12 All-You-Care-To-Eat meals per week in The Underground
- This plan is supplemented with \$175 in Dining Dollars for the semester

10 Meal Plan Plus \$1,190 + tax

- Up to 10 All-You-Care-To-Eat meals per week in The Underground
- This plan is supplemented with \$125 in Dining Dollars for the semester

8 Meal Plan Plus \$1,125 + tax

- Up to 8 All-You-Care-To-Eat meals per week in The Underground
- This plan is supplemented with \$150 in Dining Dollars for the semester

8 Meal Plan \$1,025 + tax

- Up to 8 All-You-Care-To-Eat meals per week in The Underground
- This plan is supplemented with \$50 in Dining Dollars for the semester

University Plan \$1,300 + tax

- All Dining Dollars
- This plan allows you to purchase meals "a la carte" at any retail operation or pay a fixed cash price at The Underground.
